WELCOME

Dear JHSC Family and Friends,

We celebrated our 85th season by welcoming over 200 new families to JHSC and completing our new Strategic Plan covering our goals for the next 3 years. In the past year, our 500+ student-athletes in Alpine, Backcountry, Freeride, and Nordic enjoyed a stellar year of growth and achievement in skiing and snowboarding. JHSC had four student-athletes represent the United States at International Championships, as well as numerous accolades at the national and regional levels. We graduated twelve seniors who spent a cumulative 107 years with JHSC with two of those student-athletes continuing on to ski for NCAA D1 programs.

As a Club, JHSC aims to be the preeminent competitive youth organization for winter snow sports. Our Club hosted 55 days of junior competitions across Jackson Hole Mountain Resort, Trail Creek Ranch, and Snow King Mountain. We also enjoyed over 70% staff retention across our programs and 20% of our staff are former JHSC student-athletes. Our annual and ongoing staff training is some of the best in the industry, attracting experienced and motivated coaches who return year after year to inspire the next generation of recreational and elite student-athletes who love skiing and snowboarding for life.

Your support continues to matter more than ever as we refine, expand, and advance the quality of our programs. This is only possible through extensive financial donations, volunteers, and our community and venue partners. With our goal of keeping student-athletes in winter snow sports through high school, over 20% of student-athletes received need-based scholarship support. JHSC also awarded 17 merit scholarships for athletic achievement and 12 academic scholarships for high school student-athletes with year-long academic 4.0 GPAs. In total, JHSC awarded \$166,210 in need and merit based scholarships. Donating to JHSC correlates to healthier and happier student-athletes in a community that loves snow sports!

Wow! 2023-2024 was an incredible season for JHSC Alpine ski racing! We welcomed new faces into the Alpine community, had fun with dryland in the fall, learned how to improve our turns, and enjoyed the crisp air in our lungs. We hosted 37 days of ski racing for our community and the Intermountain Region, and we were able to show off how fantastic the snow can be while hosting 7 days of U18 Nationals at both Snow King Mountain and Jackson Hole Mountain Resort. 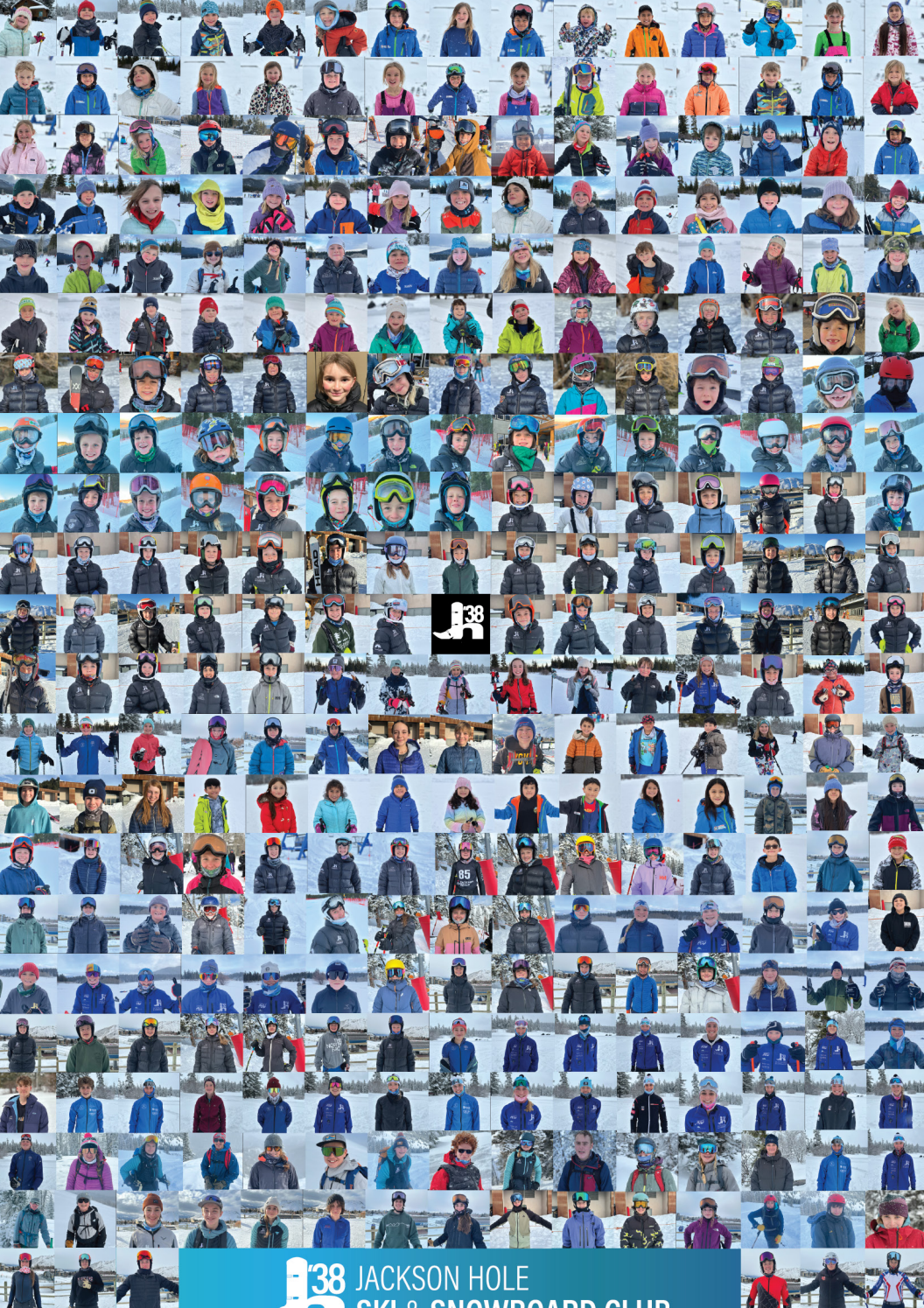
